March 7, 1967 - January 25, 2012

Scott Koster, 44 of Breda, died Wednesday, January 25, 2012 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll from injuries received in an accidental fall north of Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Monday, January 30, 2012 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Fr. Richard Remmes. Music will be by Marilyn Hundling and the St. Bernard's Choir. Lector for the funeral mass will be Scott's sister, Eileen Lewis. Gift Bearers will be Scott's nephews: Matt and Brian Koster. Eucharistic Ministers will be: Scott's brother, Chris Koster; Scott's nephew, Andy Koster, and Jean Grote. Funeral arrangements are under the direction of the Sharp Funeral Home in Breda. Born on March 7, 1967 at Carroll, Iowa, Scott Doyle Koster was the son of Leroy and Joanell (Blum) Koster. He attended St. Bernard's Grade School and

later graduated from Carroll High School with the Class of 1985. On August 16, 1986 Scott married Lori Johnson at St. Bernard's Church in Breda. He served in the United States Marine Corps where he was stationed in San Diego, Twenty-nine Palms, and Okinawa, Japan. Scott and Lori returned to the area and lived in Carroll for a brief time until moving to their current home west of Breda. Scott was employed at the Pella Corporation, Montgomery Specialty, Van Erdewyk Electric, Stork Construction, and currently was the owner of Scott Koster Electric. Scott enjoyed deer and pheasant hunting, playing cards, wrestling, shooting the breeze, and spending time with his family and many friends. He was a member of the Breda American Legion, Son's of the American Legion, and St. Bernard's Parish in Breda. Scott gave the ultimate gift of life for others through organ and tissue donation.
