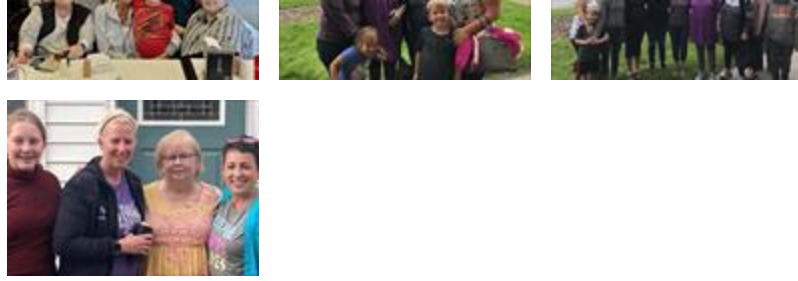
On the day Aunt Shirley passed, the scripture of the day was from Romans 8:17,18
